A RECOMMENDATION
-TO-

IMPLEMENT BETTER COURSE PLANNING SOFTWARE IN SELF SERVICE CAROLINA

WHEREAS, in 2023, Self Service Carolina included the “Schedule Planner” software which made the course registration process easier for students by allowing for the creation and customization of potential course schedules; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, this software was removed from Self Service Carolina; and

WHEREAS, now students rely on the same “Plan Ahead” software that the University of Tennessee- Knoxville utilizes, which is less comprehensive and does not provide advanced course filtering and planning functionality.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RECOMMENDED by the 117th Student Senate

THAT, the previous “Schedule Planner” software or a similar software be implemented in place of “Plan Ahead” to help students create and customize their course schedules.
