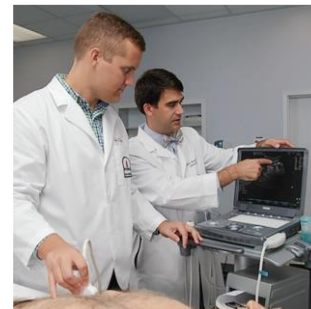


Introduction to Primary Care Ultrasound

This introduction to point of care ultrasound course provides attendees with the skills and confidence in acquisition and interpretation of ultrasound images needed to further integrate ultrasound into their primary care practices. The program is intended for primary care providers with no or minimal experience, or those brushing up on their ultrasound skills.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Attendance is appropriate for physicians, nurse practitioners and physician assistants who work in a primary care, hospitalist, or urgent care setting. No previous ultrasound imaging experience is needed.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of the program, attendees will be able to:

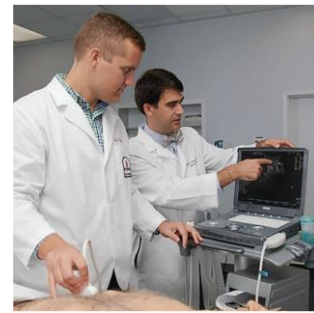
- Discuss physical characteristics of ultrasound and ultrasound machine.
- Establish basic skills in the use of laptop and handheld ultrasound units.
- Acquire images of the heart including PLAX, Apical 4-chamber, and Subcostal views
- Perform an ultrasound exam of the abdominal aorta with focus on aneurysm detection.
- Perform basic musculoskeletal ultrasound scans on large joints.
- Perform ultrasound guided procedures (paracentesis, thoracentesis, and central line placement)
- Combine imaging of heart, IVC and lungs as a means to perform a limited cardiopulmonary exam.
- Recognize an abscess on soft tissue ultrasound.
- Perform a two-zone exam for deep venous thrombosis.
- Perform basic scans of the liver, gallbladder, kidneys, and urinary bladder.
