


The **University of South Carolina College of Pharmacy Academic Fellowship** is a 12-month program designed to produce graduates as highly proficient clinical academicians who will excel in all pillars of academia – teaching, scholarship, and service. Graduates of this program will be qualified to confidently seek full time employment at a college/school of pharmacy in either a non-tenure or tenure track position.

Fellow Responsibilities



Program Level Objectives:

- Dissect the fundamentals of academia, including but not limited to course coordination, committee involvement, tenure and promotion, and mentorship
- o Apply skills in scholarly activity through research experience and scholarly deliverables
- Develop an appreciation of service through the University, College of Pharmacy, and professional organizations through active committee work and volunteerism
- Establish teaching philosophy, style, and preceptorship excellence through educational deliverables in the USC COP curriculum
- Manage and maintain an ambulatory clinical practice site while balancing concurrent academic responsibilities



Stipend: \$54,000

Location: Columbia, South Carolina at University of South Carolina College of Pharmacy

Timeline: 1-year duration with target start date in July, annually

- Eligible for pharmacist licensure in South Carolina
- Complete application through USC
